Computer Clubs for Girls is an award-winning initiative from e-skills UK, supported by DfES. Its aim is to help transform the attitudes of a generation of girls, and get them interested in technology in ways that are relevant to them – one example is by giving girls an insight into the radio industry.

Topics in the CC4G courseware which focus on the radio industry include:

- Radio waves girls compose a jingle for their favourite radio station
- > Verbalise girls design a radio ad to publicise a good cause
- > Sound byte girls choose from different conversation segments to create a dialogue. They can select voice, tones and add timings
- > Mood maker girls act as sound engineers and select sound effects to create the mood of a scene
- > It's not what you say girls select from audio clips made in different voice tones to produce the right public announcement for the situation
- > Get the story out working as a news reporter, girls select a story to cover.

  Information and pictures arrive as they are creating their story, and they have to decide what to include
