Take the flicker book sheet and carefully cut out each picture.






Hold the top edge firmly, or you could use a clip or a staple – but take care.

Now flick the pages of the flicker book so you see the first page then the next and the next one quickly after another.


If you turn over the flicker book you can use the blank pages to make your own cell animation.
